

RESPONSIBLE SUPPLY CHAIN POLICY

As IC Enterra Renewable Energy, we place great importance on conducting our supply chain and procurement operations sustainably in all regions where we operate and are represented. Our goal is to establish, maintain, and develop long-term business relationships with our suppliers based on mutual trust and cooperation. In line with this, we support our stakeholders by providing improvement-oriented feedback at regular intervals.

As IC Enterra, through this Responsible Supply Chain Policy, we adopt the following principles as a general framework:

- To carry out procurement activities in compliance with relevant legal regulations and national and international best practices,
- To use our influence as an employer to encourage our suppliers to engage in activities aligned with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals,
- To continuously improve our procurement processes from a sustainability perspective and to manage these processes with a circular economy approach,
- To prioritize suppliers who value sustainability in their operations, manage their environmental and social impacts, and show sensitivity to occupational health and safety rules,
- To prioritize the support of local suppliers,
- To maintain constant communication with suppliers and contribute to the development of sustainability awareness and consciousness,
- To conduct our supplier selection and evaluation processes transparently.

In line with these principles, our expectations from our suppliers as IC Enterra are as follows:

- To ensure that their processes are carried out in alignment with IC Enterra's policies, including but not limited to this policy;
 - IC Enterra Sustainability Policy,
 - o IC Enterra Environmental Policy,
 - o IC Enterra Human Rights Policy,
 - o IC Enterra Occupational Health and Safety Policy,
 - IC Enterra Climate Change Policy,
 - o IC Enterra Anti-Bribery and Corruption Policy.
- To fulfill all legal requirements applicable to the area of operation, not limited to environmental and occupational health and safety regulations,
- To carry out activities with respect for human rights and without any form of discrimination,
- To adopt a zero-tolerance principle against bribery, corruption, and the giving or receiving of bribes,
- To act transparently and cooperatively during both scheduled and unscheduled audits.



Purpose of the Policy

Scope of the Policy

This policy applies to all IC Enterra employees, including the IC Enterra Board of Directors, as well as all suppliers, contractors, consultants, lawyers, auditors, and all other individuals and entities acting on behalf of IC Enterra from whom goods or services are procured.

Implementation of the Policy and Relevant Legislation

This policy has been established by concretizing and organizing the rules set forth by applicable legislation and similar regulations within the framework of IC Enterra practices. In case of any inconsistency between the applicable legislation and this policy, IC Enterra acknowledges that the provisions of the applicable legislation shall prevail.
